Out of the 50 sites available at the Camp site, 10 will have Tipi tents prepared.

The 40 sites will be available for those who would like to bring their own tents.

The Recreation Dome will have 30 sites available total, 20 sites will have tents prepared.

The remaining 10 sites will be available for those who would like to bring their own tents.

Those who have made reservations for the Outdoor Cooking, please come to the Camp Site brick ovens by 18:00

# ! Attention !

1. Park gate closes at 9:30pm. Vehicles will not be able to enter/exit until the next day after road blocks have been reopened.
2. Those participating in the Okinawa Marathon and their family will be able to make reservations for the campsite.
3. Reservations will be first come, first served basis.
4. At check-in you will need to show proof of participation in the marathon (receipt, number, etc.)
5. Payment for campsites will be accepted on February 17. No refunds.
6. Rental items, other than tents, will charged seperately.

7. Open fires are prohibited inside the Recreation Dome. Fires when preparing meals will be allowed outside around the Recreation Dome.
8. Concerning reservations made at the Recreation Dome, parking will be provided at the field next to the Recreation Dome. Lights will turn off at 9:00pm and will turn back on at 6:30am.

# Camp Ground Restrictions

1. Please place vehicle pass where visible.
2. One vehicle parked per campsite.
3. Please keep hazard lights on when driving within the campground. Speed limit is 10km.
4. Please do not park on the road in the campground or on the grass.
5. Do not leave vehicle head lights or engine on, other than when driving
6. Park gate closed between 9:30pm to 6:00am. Vehicles will not be able to pass.  
※Emergency vehicles only
7. The use of Fireworks, Bon-Fire, Karaoke, and Generators are restricted.
8. Please be considerate of others around. Keep noise level and music down, especially at night.
9. Pets are not permitted for overnight stays. If pets are brought during the day, pets must be kept on a leash.
10. Children must be accompanied by parent/guardian.
11. Please take trash with you when you leave. Trash can be discarded for you when placed in trash bags purchased at the Camp center. (300yen a bag.)
12. Direct fires on the grass is prohibited, due to the damage it will cause the grass. Please use barbeque grills for fires. Also, fire pits located on the campground are provided for your use. Please do not use water to extinguish fires. The hot water that drains from the grill will damage the grass. To extinguish the fire let the fire burn out or dispose of the charcoal in designated area provided next to the fire pits.
13. Strong winds and wind direction can cause sparks to fly. Please be aware of your surrounding that may be damaged from flames or sparks. Such as tents, cars, or flammable items. Park management will not be responsible for any damage caused.
14. When adding materials to a fire such as paper or leaves, it can cause the temperature of the fire to rise and cause sparks to fly. Burning moist wood, cardboard, ink, substances, or etc. can cause asthma attacks and allergies from the smoke. Please be cautious.
